

Ordinance No. 637

AN ORDINANCE adopting and enforcing daylight saving time in the City of Alexandria, Virginia for the period beginning at 2 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., April 30 1950, and ending at 2 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., September 24, 1950.

Whereas, the Governor of Virginia having given his approval in writing pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-24.2 of the Code of Virginia, 1950.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That daylight saving time be and the same hereby is adopted as the official time in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, in all the area within the corporate limits thereof, for the period beginning at 2 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., April 30, 1950, and ending at 2 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., September 24, 1950 and all clocks in the City shall be set back one hour at the end of said period.

Section 2. That daylight saving time provided for in Section 1 hereof for the period beginning at 2 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., April 30, 1950, and ending at 2 o'clock A.M., E.S.T., September 24, 1950, shall govern the conduct of all business and elections in the City of Alexandria, Virginia during that time and period.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective at 2 o'clock A. M., E.S.T., April 30, 1950.
