

Ordinance No. 640

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 41 as amended, Chapter II of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, which said chapter relates to traffic and which said section relates to time limits for parking meters.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. That Section 41 as amended, Chapter II of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 41. Time Limits.

The time limits for parking in any space in said parking meter zones shall be determined by deposit of a coin in each parking meter as follows, provided that the time limit for parking shall in no case exceed two hours:

Any period of time up to one hour for five cents (5c)—One Nickel.

Any period of time up to two hours for ten cents (10c)—Two (2) Nickels.

The hours of the day or night during which the parking meter restrictions shall be in force shall be determined by the Traffic Board of the City of Alexandria, provided that no charge or charges shall be made for parking on Sundays and legal holidays.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
