

# Ordinance No. 657

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of King Street at its intersection with Janney's Lane, one of the public streets of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.**

WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that said portion of King Street is not needed for public use and it is in the public interest to vacate the same.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the portion of King Street at its intersection with Janney's Lane more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the existing southwesterly line of King Street, said point being the northeasterly corner of Lot 3, Block 5, George Washington Park and running thence with said southwesterly line of King Street, N 46° 58' 44" W 69.83 ft. to a point; thence with the arc of a curve to the right whose radius is 44.50 ft., whose chord is 13.57 ft., whose chord bearing is S 56° 52' 55" E 13.62 ft., to a point; thence S. 48° 06' 48" E 56.40 ft., to a point; thence S 41° 53' 12" W 3.46 ft., to the point of beginning and containing 184 square feet;

be and the same hereby is vacated, closed and abandoned as a public street and thoroughfare.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
