

Ordinance No. 662

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of South Patrick Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, application has been made to the Council for the appointment of viewers to view and report in writing whether in their opinion, any, and if any, what inconvenience would result from discontinuing and vacating South Patrick Street from the southerly line of Church Street to the northerly line of South Street, and

WHEREAS, a notice of such application was posted at the Court House of the Corporation Court of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and at two public places in the City in the manner required by law, and

WHEREAS, Council did appoint Coleman C. Batcheller, Charles T. Nicholson and John P. Strauss as such viewers for such purposes, and

WHEREAS, said viewers have reported to the City Planning Commission, in the manner required by the City Charter, that in their opinion the discontinuing and vacation of said street would not cause any inconvenience to the City of Alexandria or its citizens, or to adjoining property owners and should, therefore be vacated, and

WHEREAS, the said report of the said viewers has been duly ratified, approved and confirmed by the City Planning Commission at its meeting held on Thursday, November 2, 1950, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed that the welfare and best interests of the City and its citizens will be served by the vacation and abandonment of said portion of said street;

The City of Alexandria hereby ordains:

SECTION 1. That the herein after described portion of South Patrick Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned:

All of that portion of Patrick Street lying between the south line of Church Street and the north line of South Street as extended eastwardly from the present west line of said Patrick Street, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the south line of Church Street with the east line of Patrick Street; thence with the east line of Patrick Street S. 09° 30' W. 315.40 ft. to the north line of South Street; thence with the north line of South Street along the arc of a curve to the right (radius 835.44 ft.) 66.27 ft. to the west line of Patrick Street; thence with the west line of said Patrick Street N. 09° 30' E. 319.72 ft. to the south line of Church Street; thence S. 80° 49' E. 66.08 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 21,012 sq. ft.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
