

## Ordinance No. 667

AN ORDINANCE to repeal Chapter VII-D of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, which said chapter was added to the said code by Ordinance No. 639 enacted May 9, 1950 and relates to the levy and imposition of a tax on the sale of cigarettes at retail within the City of Alexandria, definitions, rate and amount of such tax payment, utilization of revenues resulting therefrom, defining violations and prescribing penalties therefor, and separability of the provisions thereof. This ordinance provides further for the redemption of cigarette tax stamps.

### THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. That Chapter VII-D of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, which said chapter was added to the said code by Ordinance No. 639 enacted May 9, 1950, be and the same hereby is repealed.

2. That all stamps as defined in Sec. 1 (m) of said Chapter VII-D which have been sold by the City and not affixed to a package of cigarettes on the effective date of this ordinance, may be redeemed at net cost to the purchaser within 15 days after the said effective date. No such stamps will be redeemed at the expiration of the aforesaid 15 day period, and all such stamps which are not redeemed shall be null and void.

3. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its final passage.
