

## Ordinance No. 672

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of Cherry Street running from the East line of the Mt. Vernon Memorial Highway eastwardly to the Potomac River, one of the public streets of the City of Alexandria, Virginia,**

WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that such portion of Cherry Street is not needed for public use and whereas it is in the public interest to vacate same,

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:**

1. That the portion of Cherry Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, running from the East line of the Mt. Vernon Memorial Highway eastwardly to the Potomac River, be and the same hereby is vacated, closed and abandoned as a public street and thoroughfare.
2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
