

Ordinance No. 677

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 40, as amended, Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, which said chapter relates to traffic and said section relates to parking meter zones.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. That Section 40, as amended, Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 40. Parking Meter Zones Established.

The following described parts of the streets of the City of Alexandria are hereby established as parking meter zones:

(a) Both sides of King Street from Lee Street to Commonwealth Avenue.

(b) Both sides of the 100 block north and the 100 block south of each street intersecting with King Street from Fairfax Street to West Street, both inclusive.

(c) Both sides of the 200 block North Washington Street and 200 block South Washington Street.

(d) Both sides of Cameron Street between Fairfax Street and Washington Street, and both sides of Cameron Street between Columbus Street and Alfred Street.

(e) Both sides of Prince Street between St. Asaph Street and Columbus Street.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
