

Ordinance No. 688

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of an alley in the block bounded by Franklin, Alfred, Gibbon and Columbus Streets, one of the public alleys of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that such portion of the alley in the block bounded by Franklin, Alfred, Gibbon and Columbus Streets is not needed for public use and whereas it is in the public interest to vacate same;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. That the portion of the public alley in the block bounded by Franklin, Alfred, Gibbon and Columbus Streets, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north side of Franklin Street, said point being 109.00 feet west of Columbus Street; thence west along the north line of Franklin Street 10.00 feet to a point; thence north parallel to Columbus Street 176.58 feet to a point; thence east parallel to Franklin 10.00 feet to a point; thence south parallel to Columbus Street 176.58 feet to the point of beginning;

be and the same hereby is vacated, closed and abandoned as a public alley.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
