

Ordinance No. 703

AN ORDINANCE making further provision for defraying the general expense of the public schools and appropriating from the General Fund a sum of money for such expense.

WHEREAS: By virtue of "The Battle Grant" there is available in the General Fund of the City the sum of \$130,000.00 unencumbered and unappropriated, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Sec. 1. That the sum of \$130,000.00 be and the same hereby is appropriated from the General Fund of the City of Alexandria and is allotted to the Alexandria public schools for the purpose of defraying the general expenses of said schools.

Sec. 2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
