

## Ordinance No. 706

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 10, Chapter 27, and all amendments thereto, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, which said section relates to Fees for examinations, and which Chapter relates to Plumbing

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. That Section 10, Chapter 27, and all amendments thereto, of the code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 10. Fees for examinations.

The fee for the first examination of master plumbers shall be \$10.00 and the fee for the first examination of journeymen plumbers shall be \$2.50. The fee for the first examination of master and journeymen gas fitters shall be \$2.50. Such fees shall accompany the application, but no fee shall be required for subsequent re-examinations.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
