

# Ordinance No. 707

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 11, Chapter 27, and all amendments thereto, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 2, 1940, which said section relates to period for licenses; fee licenses and renewals and which Chapter relates to Plumbing

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. That Section 11, Chapter 27, and all amendments thereto of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 2, 1940, be and the same here amended to read as follows:

Sec. 11 Period for licenses; fees for licenses and renewals.

The license period shall be the calendar year of the city. The license shall date from the first day of the month during which applicant for license shall satisfactorily pass the prescribed examination and shall end December 31, following. The fee for the first license as a master plumber shall be \$25.00 for any part of the first license period and shall be paid at the time of issuance. The fee for the license as a master gas fitter shall be \$5.00 for any part of the license period and shall be paid at the time of issuance. Renewals shall be for the full calendar year of the city, and the fee for the master plumber's renewal shall be \$10.00 and the fee for the master gas fitter renewal shall be \$2.50. An application for renewal shall be accompanied by the license fee, and shall be made in person before the expiration of a prior license. The plumbing board shall have power to refuse renewal of any license allowed to lapse and it may in such case require re-application for a new license to be issued only after passing examination as hereinbefore provided. The fee for the journeyman plumbers and journeymen gas fitters renewal shall be \$2.00.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading of the ordinance, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
