

Ordinance No. 711

AN ORDINANCE making provision for the support of the government of the City of Alexandria for the territory annexed to the City from Fairfax County on December 31, 1951, for the payment of interest and principal of the City debt, and for other municipal expenses and purpose and appropriating to the several funds the amounts required to defray the expenditures and liabilities of the municipal corporation for the period beginning at midnight 1951 and ending on the 30th day of June 1952.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, does hereby make provision for and appropriates to the several funds hereinafter named the several amounts required to defray the expenditures and liabilities of the municipal corporation for the period beginning at midnight on the 31st day of December 1951 and ending on the 30th day of June 1952, payable from the general funds and from any other funds created by law as follows:

(A) General and School Fund:

1. For defraying the general expenses of the corporation the sum of\$ 86,079.50
2. For defraying the general expenses of the public schools, the sum of 135,180.00

(B) For the payment of the public debt of the corporation and the interest thereon, the sum of 10,000.00

GRAND TOTAL \$231,259.50

Section 2. That it is ordered that the allotment of money appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance to the several municipal departments and their functional divisions for the period beginning at midnight on the 31st day of December 1951 and ending on the 30th day of June, 1952 shall be as follows:

Section 4. That the title of this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
