

Ordinance No. 713

AN ORDINANCE to amend Title VII, Article 1, Chapter XI as amended by Ordinance No. 671 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, by adding a new section thereto numbered Sec. 97.1, which said new Sec. 97.1 relates to angle parking, which said Title VII relates to parking and stopping on highways and which said Article 1 and Chapter XI relates to traffic generally.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Title VII, Article 1, Chapter XI as amended by Ordinance No. 671 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia enacted as a whole July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section numbered Sec. 97.1 to read as follows:

Sec. 97.1 ANGLE PARKING. All vehicles and other type of mobile equipment when loading and unloading shall park at an angle of 45 degrees or less from the curb line and when practical they shall park parallel to the curb. In cases of extreme hardship a special permit, which will allow parking at an angle exceeding 45 degrees at a specific location only may be secured from the Traffic Board. Such special permits shall be issued to the property owner effected and not to drivers and shall be displayed upon the request of any police officer.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
