

Ordinance No. 716

AN ORDINANCE to vacate all of those portions of Henry Street, Fayette Street, Church Street, and Green Street lying west of the West line of U. S. No. 1 Highway, east of the East line of Payne Street, south of the South line of Jefferson Street and north of the South line of Church Street, all being public streets in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission of the City of Alexandria and by viewers appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria; and

WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia that the portion of the streets above mentioned are not needed for public use and it is in the public interest to vacate the same

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That all those portions of Henry Street, Fayette Street, Church Street, and Green Street lying west of the West line of the U. S. No. 1 Highway, east of the East line of Payne Street, south of the South line of Jefferson Street and north of the South line of Church Street, all being public streets in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby are vacated, closed and abandoned as public streets and thoroughfares.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
