

Ordinance No. 734

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of Fayette Street, one of the public streets of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, proper notice having been posted, viewers having been appointed and having approved the hereinafter mentioned vacation, and the City Planning Commission of Alexandria having recommended said vacation, and other conditions of law having been met; it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the following described portion of Fayette Street is not needed for public use and that it is in the public interest to vacate the same;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. That the easterly 16.25 feet of Fayette Street running from an extension of the northerly line of property owned by Theresa K. Guiffre to the southerly line of a right of way belonging to the Mutual Ice Company, which right of way runs from Henry Street in a westerly direction across the northerly boundary of property formerly owned by A. C. Slagle, deceased, and across the intersection with Fayette Street, as the same appears upon plat of Redivision of Lot 601 of property of A. C. Slagle, dated April 27, 1951, and prepared by Cecil J. Cross, Certified Surveyor, be, and the same hereby is, vacated, closed and abandoned as a public street and thoroughfare.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in the Alexandria Gazette not later than two days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
