

Ordinance No. 741

AN ORDINANCE to vacate that portion of Church Street lying between the west line of south Royal Street and the west line of South Pitt Street, all being public streets in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at a regular meeting held May 8, 1952, and approved by viewers appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, and

WHEREAS, a notice of application for appointment of such viewers was posted at the Courthouse of the Corporation of Alexandria, Virginia, and at two public places in the City in the manner required by law, and

WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the portion of the street above mentioned is not needed for public use and it is in the public interest to vacate the same

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described portion of Church Street, a public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned:

All that portion of Church Street lying between the west line of South Royal Street and the west line of South Pitt Street, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the west line of South Royal Street and the north line of Church Street; thence southwardly to the intersection of the west line of South Royal Street and the south line of Church Street; thence westwardly to the intersection of the west line of South Pitt Street and the south line of Church Street; thence northwardly to the intersection of the west line of South Pitt Street and the north line of Church Street; thence eastwardly along the north line of Church Street to a point of beginning.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
