

Ordinance No. 744

AN ORDINANCE making further provision for the support of the government of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and for other municipal expenses and purposes, and appropriating to the several funds the additional amounts required to defray the expenditures and liabilities of the municipal corporation for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of July 1951 and ending on the 30th day of June, 1952.

WHEREAS there is available in the general fund the sum of \$92,650.00, unencumbered and unappropriated and,

WHEREAS there are certain accounts which have or will exceed their appropriations

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia does hereby make further provision for and appropriates to the General Fund hereinafter named, the additional amount required to defray the expenditures and liabilities of the municipal corporation for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of July 1951, and ending on the 30th day of June, 1952, payable from the general funds and from any other fund created by law as follows:

A. General Fund, for the general expenses
of the Corporation the sum of \$92,650.00

Section 2. That it is ordered that the allotment of money appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance to the several municipal departments and their functional divisions for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of July, 1951 and ending on the 30th day of June, 1952, shall be as follows:

Section 3. That the money hereinabove mentioned is to be provided for as follows:

Unanticipated Personal Property Taxes 1951-52	\$27,550.00
Sale of Real Estate 1951-52	65,100.00

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than two days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
