

Ordinance No. 747

AN ORDINANCE to amend section 9 of Chapter 31 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, said section 9 relating to DRUNKENNESS IN PUBLIC PLACE, and said Chapter 31 relating to OFFENSES AND PUNISHMENT.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That section 9 of Chapter 31 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 9. DRUNKENNESS IN PUBLIC PLACE.

If any person appear in any public place under the influence of intoxicants, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof he shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$300.00, or be imprisoned in jail for not more than 90 days, or be both fined and imprisoned, in the discretion of the Court.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
