

Ordinance No. 751

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain section 65 of Article III, Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, which said section 65 relates to HOURS AND DAYS APPLICABLE, which said Article III relates to PARKING LOTS AND PARKING METERS, and which said Chapter XI relates to TRAFFIC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That section 65 of Article III, Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 65. HOURS AND DAYS APPLICABLE.

The parking meters in the parking meter zones hereinbefore provided for shall be operated between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. daily, Monday through Saturday, provided that on Fridays the operative hours shall be extended to 9:00 p.m., and provided further that no charge or charges for parking shall be made on Sundays or legal holidays.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than Five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
