

# Ordinance No. 752

**AN ORDINANCE to discontinue and vacate certain alleys and courts within the squares bounded by North Columbus, Wythe, North Alfred and Madison Streets: a court and certain alleys within the square bounded by North Columbus, Madison, North Alfred and Montgomery Streets; a court and certain alleys within the square bounded by North Columbus, Montgomery, North Alfred and First Streets; and all alleys within the square bounded by North Alfred, Madison, North Patrick and Montgomery Streets, all being alleys and courts in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.**

WHEREAS, said discontinuance and vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission, at a regular meeting held September 4, 1952, and approved by viewers appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, and

WHEREAS, a notice of application for such discontinuance and vacation and for appointment of such viewers was posted at the front door of the Courthouse of the Corporation Court of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, on the 8th day of September, 1952, the first day of the September Term of said Court, and at two public places in the City, and notice was given to abutting property owners in the manner required by law, and

WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the said alleys and courts above mentioned are not needed for public use and it is in the public interest to discontinue and vacate the same

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:**

Section 1. That the hereinafter described courts and alleys located in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby are discontinued and vacated and abandoned;

(1) All alleys and courts within the square of ground in said City, bounded by North Columbus, Wythe, North Alfred and Madison Streets, LESS AND EXCEPT a portion of an existing alley 8.5 feet wide running parallel with North Columbus Street, north from Wythe Street, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the north line of Wythe Street N. 80° 49' W 90.75 feet from the intersection of the west line of North Columbus Street and the north line of Wythe Street; thence N. 80° 49' W along the north line of Wythe Street 8.5 feet; thence N. 9° 30' W 158.00 feet to a point; thence S. 80° 49' E. 8.5 feet to a point; thence S. 9° 30' E. 158.00 feet to the point of beginning.

(2) A court and all alleys within the square bounded by North Columbus, Madison, North Alfred and Montgomery Streets, LESS AND EXCEPT that portion of an existing alley 10 feet wide,

running north from Madison Street, and part of said court, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north line of Madison Street N. 80° 49' W. 90.00 feet from the intersection of the north line of Madison Street and the west line of North Columbus Street; thence along the north line of Madison Street N. 80° 49' W 10.00 feet to a point; thence N. 9° 30' E. 211.59 feet to a point; thence S. 80° 49' E. 10.00 feet to a point; thence S. 9° 30' W. 211.59 feet to the point of beginning.

(3) A court and all alleys within the square bounded by North Columbus, Montgomery, North Alfred and First Streets, LESS AND EXCEPT an existing alley 10 feet wide running north from Montgomery Street and part of said court described as follows: Beginning at a point on the north line of Montgomery Street N. 80° 49' W. 90.00 feet from the intersection of the north line of Montgomery Street and the west line of North Columbus Street; thence along the north line of Montgomery Street N. 80° 49' W. 10.00 feet to a point; thence N 9° 30' E. 176.59 feet to a point; thence S 80° 49' E 10.00 feet to a point; thence S. 9° 30' W 176.59 feet to the point of beginning.

(4) All alleys within the square bounded by North Alfred, Madison, North Patrick and Montgomery Streets.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
