

Ordinance No. 753

AN ORDINANCE to vacate that portion of West Uhler Avenue from the west line of Alexander Street to a point 115.75 feet west of Alexander Street, less and except a strip 10 feet wide and symmetrical with the existing center line of West Uhler Avenue, said West Uhler Avenue being a public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings, and

WHEREAS a notice of application for appointment of viewers was posted at the Courthouse of the Corporation of Alexandria, Virginia, and at two other public places in the City in the manner required by law, and

WHEREAS said viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and

WHEREAS said vacation has been approved by said viewers, and WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the portion of the street above mentioned is not needed for public use and it is in the public interest to vacate the same

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described portion of West Uhler Avenue, a public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned:

All that portion of West Uhler Avenue lying west of the west line of Alexander Street, to a point 115.75 feet west of Alexander Street, less and except a strip 10 ft. wide and symmetrical with the existing center line of West Uhler Avenue, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point, which point is at the intersection of the west line of Alexander Street and the north line of West Uhler Avenue; thence westwardly along the north line of West Uhler Avenue a distance of 115.75 feet; thence departing from said line in a southerly direction and at right angles to said line, a distance of 40 feet to the south line of West Uhler Avenue; thence eastwardly along the south line of West Uhler Avenue a distance of 115.75 feet to the intersection of said south line of West Uhler Avenue and the west line of Alexander Street; thence northwardly along the west line of Alexander Street a distance of 40 feet to the point of beginning; LESS AND EXCEPT a strip more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west line of Alexander Street, which point is five feet north of the intersection of the existing center line of West Uhler Avenue and the west line of Alexander Street; thence westwardly along a line, said line being parallel to and 5 feet northerly from the existing center line of West Uhler Avenue, a distance of 115.75 feet; thence departing from said line and at right angles to said line, in a southerly direction a distance of 10 feet along a line parallel to the west line of Alexander Street; thence eastwardly along a line, said line being parallel to and 5 feet southerly from the existing center line of West Uhler Avenue, a distance of 115.75 feet to the intersection of said line with the west line of Alexander Street; thence northwardly along the west line of Alexander Street a distance of 10 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
