Ordinance No. 773

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 76, Article IV, of Chapter VII, as amended by Ordinance No. 521, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, which said Section 76 relates to PASSENGER AUTOMOBILES, which said Article IV relates to MOTOR VEHICLES; TRUCKS AND TRAILERS; MOTORCYCLES, and which said Chapter VII and Ordinance No. 521 relates to CITY LICENSE TAXES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Sec. 76, Article IV, of Chapter VII, as amended by Ordinance No. 521, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 76. PASSENGER AUTOMOBILES.

On all automobiles designed for the transportation of passengers, and used regularly by local residents on the streets of this City, there shall be an annual license tax for each vehicle in the amount of Seven Dollars. Each automobile shall be provided with a proper City license tag which shall be securely attached to either the front or rear State license tag and kept in full view at all times.

This section is subject to the limitations set forth in sections 46-64 and 46-65 of the Code of Virginia (1950) as amended.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the fifteenth day of March, 1953.
