

Ordinance No. 781

AN ORDINANCE appropriating a sum of money to help defray the expense of installing certain sanitary sewers within the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS due to the construction of a number of large housing projects within the city the funds within the present budget for sanitary sewers are insufficient, and

WHEREAS it is essential that adequate sanitary sewers be completed at the same time that housing projects are completed, and,

WHEREAS there is available to the City the sum of SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN DOLLARS and FIFTY-EIGHT CENTS (\$77,377.58) unencumbered and unappropriated, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Sec. 1. That the sum of SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN DOLLARS and FIFTY-EIGHT CENTS (\$77,377.58) be and the same hereby is appropriated and allotted to the construction of sanitary sewers within the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
