

Ordinance No. 785

AN ORDINANCE appropriating from the several bond accounts of the City of Alexandria to be used for constructing new school buildings and additions to existing school buildings, improving existing school buildings and acquiring necessary land and equipment; constructing and equipping an incinerator and acquiring necessary land therefor; constructing and equipping a public building for use as a public library; reconstructing the Cameron Street Swimming Pool; constructing, paving, widening and otherwise improving streets, including bridges, viaducts and underpasses; and constructing storm water sewers.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the sum of \$4,550,000.00 be and the same hereby is appropriated from the several bond accounts of the City of Alexandria, Virginia and hereby is allocated for the following purposes:

- (1) From the 1953 School Bond Account to be used in constructing new school buildings and additions to existing school buildings, improving existing school buildings, and acquiring necessary land and equipment, the sum of\$2,310,000.00
- (2) From the Incinerator Bond Account to be used in constructing and equipping an incinerator and acquiring necessary land therefor, the sum of\$800,000.00
- (6) From the Public Library Bond Account to be used in constructing and equipping a public building for use as a public library, the sum of\$155,000.00
- (4) From the Cameron Street Swimming Pool Bond Account to be used in reconstructing the Cameron Street Swimming Pool, the sum of\$85,000.00
- (5) From the 1953 Street Bond Account to be used in constructing, paving, widening and otherwise improving streets, including bridges, viaducts and underpasses, the sum of\$725,000.00
- (6) From the 1953 Storm Sewer Bond Account to be used in constructing storm water sewers, the sum of\$475,000.00

Section 2. That before any project calling for the expenditure of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance be started, such project must be approved by a majority vote of the Council members present at any lawful meeting of the City Council of Alexandria.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
