

Ordinance No. 786

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (b) of Section 1, Chapter IX of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, as amended by Ordinance No. 499 and Ordinance No. 769, which said subsection (b) designates names of certain streets, which said Section 1 relates to NAMES OF STREETS, and which said Chapter IX relates to STREETS AND SIDEWALKS GENERALLY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (b) of Section 1, Chapter IX of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, enacted as a whole July 2, 1940, and made effective August 5, 1940, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 1(b). On July 1, 1953, the names of the following streets shall be changed and re-named and designated by their new names on the official map cited in (c) below, as follows:

Section 2. That the "Official Street Naming Map, City of Alexandria, Virginia," on file in the office of the Director of Planning, be amended to conform with the provisions of Section 1 above.

Section 3. That in the opinion of Council, an emergency exists and this ordinance is hereby declared "AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE" for the reason that the house numbering program now underway in the annexed area, urgently needed for the orderly development of said area, is being held up pending completion of the provisions herein contained, and that further delay will be detrimental to the interests of the City.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not more than five days after its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
