

## Ordinance No. 798

**AN ORDINANCE to amend Chapter 20, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953 by adding a new section thereto numbered Sec. 20-44, which Chapter 20 relates to Offenses—Miscellaneous, and which new section relates to abandoned, unattended or discarded ice boxes, refrigerators and other containers and provides penalties for violation.**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA HEREBY ORDAINS:**

Section 1. That Chapter 20 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia 1953 be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new section numbered Sec. 20-44 to read as follows:

**Sec. 20-44. Discarded ice boxes, refrigerators and containers.**

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to leave outside of any building or dwelling in a place accessible to children, any abandoned, unattended or discarded ice box, refrigerator or any other container of any kind which has an air-tight type snap-lock or other securing device thereon without first removing the said snap-lock and/or device and/or doors from said ice box, refrigerator or container.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
