

# Ordinance No. 800

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate that portion of South West Street from the south line of Duke Street to the north line of the Southern Railway right of way, less and except a strip forty-five feet wide and symmetrical with the existing center line of South West Street, said South West Street being a public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.**

WHEREAS said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings, and

WHEREAS a notice of application for appointment of viewers was posted at the Courthouse of the Corporation of Alexandria, Virginia, and at two other public places in the City in the manner required by law, and

WHEREAS said viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and

WHEREAS said vacation has been approved by said viewers, and

WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the portion of the street above mentioned and designated for vacation, is not needed for public use and it is in the public interest to vacate the same.

## THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That all of that portion of South West Street, running from the south line of Duke Street southward to the north line of the Southern Railway right of way, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned, LESS AND EXCEPT a strip forty-five feet wide and symmetrical with the existing center line of South West Street, said strip being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the south line of Duke Street, which point is twenty-two and one-half (22.5) feet west of the intersection of the south line of Duke Street and the existing center line of South West Street; thence southward along a line parallel to and twenty-two and one-half (22.5) feet from the existing center line of South West Street a distance of 297 feet, more or less, to the north line of the Southern Railway right of way; thence along the north line of the Southern Railway right of way eastward a distance of forty-five (45) feet; then departing from the north line of the Southern Railway right of way in a northward direction along a line parallel to and twenty-two and one-half (22.5) feet from the existing center line of South West Street a distance of 297 feet, more or less, to the south line of Duke Street; thence westward along the south line of Duke Street forty-five feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
