

Ordinance No. 805

AN ORDINANCE to vacate that portion of Montgomery Street lying west of the west line of Henry Street and east of the east line of Fayette Street, reserving, however, to the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a sewer right of way and easement as hereinafter set forth, said streets being public streets in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings; and

WHEREAS, a notice of application for appointment of viewers was posted at the Courthouse of the Corporation of Alexandria, Virginia, and at two other public places in the City in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, said viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia; and

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by said viewers; and

WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the portion of the public street above mentioned is not needed for public use and it is in the public interest to vacate the same,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described portion of Montgomery Street, a public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be, and the same hereby is, vacated and abandoned:

All that portion of Montgomery Street lying west of the west line of Henry Street and east of the east line of Fayette Street, reserving, however, to the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a storm sewer right of way and easement therein, thereon, and thereover, ten feet wide and extending from the west line of Henry Street to the east line of Fayette Street, the center line of which said right of way and easement is the same as the existing center line of Montgomery Street.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
