

Ordinance No. 808

AN ORDINANCE appropriating a sum of money to help defray the expense of installing certain sanitary sewers within the "BROOKVILLE PROJECT" in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, due to the construction of a large housing development, commonly known as the "BROOKVILLE PROJECT," within the City, funds within the present budget for sanitary sewers are insufficient; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that adequate sanitary sewers be completed at approximately the same time that said housing project is completed; and

WHEREAS, there is available to the City the sum of Sixteen Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Seven and 52/100 Dollars (\$16,237.52) unencumbered and unappropriated, which sum was paid to the City by the developer of said project for its sewer permit.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the sum of Sixteen Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-seven and 52/100 Dollars (\$16,237.52) be, and the same hereby is, appropriated and allotted for the construction of sanitary sewers within the BROOKVILLE PROJECT within the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
