

Ordinance No. 809

AN ORDINANCE to vacate and abandon an unnamed public alley in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, located within the subdivision of the Northwest Alexandria Improvement Company and extending between Stonewall Road and High Street, more particularly described below.

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings; and

WHEREAS, a notice of application for appointment of viewers was posted at the Courthouse of the Corporation of Alexandria, Virginia, and at two other public places in the City in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, said viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia; and

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by said viewers; and

WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the alley above mentioned is not needed for public use and it is in the public interest to vacate the same,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described public alley located in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be, and the same hereby is, vacated and abandoned:

All of that alley situate in the subdivision of the Northwest Alexandria Improvement Company in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, running from Stonewall Road (formerly Arlington Avenue) to High Street (formerly Braddock Street), and separating Lots 7, 8 and 9 from Lots 10 and 11, in Block 20 of said subdivision of Northwest Improvement Company, as the same appears duly dedicated, platted and recorded among the land records of Arlington County, Virginia, in Deed Book M, No. 4, at page 92.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
