

# Ordinance No. 812

**AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 19-20, Division 1, Article II, Chapter 19, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which said Section 19-20 relates to COMPOSITION; ESTABLISHMENT; COMPENSATION; CHAIRMAN OF TRAFFIC AND PARKING BOARD, which said Division 1 relates to TRAFFIC AND PARKING BOARD, which said Article II relates to POWERS OF LOCAL AUTHORITIES; SIGNS, SIGNALS AND MARKERS GENERALLY; TRAFFIC-CONTROL DEVICES, and which Chapter 19 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC.**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:**

Section 1. That Section 19-20, Division 1, Article II, Chapter 19, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained to read as follows:

**Sec. 19-20. Composition; Establishment; Compensation; Chairman.**

There is hereby established a Traffic and Parking Board which shall be composed of seven residents of the City of Alexandria who are not serving on any other official City body. Said members shall be appointed by the City Council for terms of two years, provided, however, that the initial appointments made under the authority of this section shall be one-year terms for four of the members and two-year terms for the other three members. Members of the Board shall serve without compensation and may be removed by the City Council for neglect of duty or malfeasance in office, upon written notice and after public hearing. Vacancies on the Board shall be filled by Council-appointment for the balance of the unexpired term. The chairman of the Board shall be appointed by the members of the Board.

The Director of Traffic, the Superintendent of Police or the Chief of the Traffic Division of the Police Department, the City Manager or his representative, the Director of Public Works or his representative, and the Director of Planning or his representative, shall regularly sit with said Board in an advisory capacity only, but all officers, departments, boards, commissions and agencies of the City shall be available to said Board for assistance and advice.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective March 15, 1954.
