

# Ordinance No. 831

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate that portion of a public alley in the rear of the 900 block of Oronoco Street, running westwardly from the west side of North Alfred Street for a distance of one hundred three and one-half (103.5) feet, having an approximate width of ten (10) feet, and being adjacent to the property now owned by Harper Laundry Company, Incorporated, formerly known as Banner Laundry Company.**

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings, and

WHEREAS, a notice of application for appointment of viewers was posted at the Courthouse of the Corporation of Alexandria, Virginia, and at two other public places in the City in the manner required by law, and

WHEREAS, said viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria and made their report, and

WHEREAS, on consideration of the report of said viewers, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the portion of the alley above mentioned and hereinafter described is not needed for public use and that it is in the public interest to vacate the same.

## THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described portion of a public alley in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned:

Beginning on the west side of North Alfred Street, at a point approximately one hundred (100) feet from the northwest intersection of Alfred Street and Oronoco Street, and having a width of approximately ten (10) feet, and running thence west for a distance of one hundred three and one-half (103.5) feet.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
