

Ordinance No. 846

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 17-47, Article II, Chapter 17 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which said Section 17-47 relates to COIN-OPERATED DEVICES—SLOT MACHINE OPERATORS; which said Article II relates to REGULATORY LICENSES, and which said Chapter 17 relates to LICENSES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Sec. 17-47, Article II, Chapter 17 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 17-47. SAME—SLOT MACHINE OPERATORS

Every person selling, leasing, renting or otherwise furnishing slot machines to others, or placing a slot machine with others, shall be deemed to be a slot machine operator. Every slot machine operator, as herein defined, shall pay for the privilege of doing business in the city an annual license tax of \$1000.00. The license tax imposed by this section is not in lieu of, but in addition to the other license taxes imposed by the preceding or the following sections; provided that the slot machine operator's license imposed by this section shall not apply to operators of weighing machines, automatic baggage or parcel checking machines, washing or drying machines, or to vending machines so constructed as to do nothing but vend merchandise, postage stamps, or to machines which provide service only, or to musical machines or devices, or to viewing machines or photomat machines, or to devices or machines affording rides to children.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
