

Ordinance No. 849

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sec. 17-40, Article II, Chapter 17 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Sec. 17-40 relates to Boarding and Rooming Houses, which Article II relates to REGULATORY LICENSES and which Chapter 17 relates to LICENSES GENERALLY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Sec. 17-40, Article II, Chapter 17, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 17-40 BOARDING AND ROOMING HOUSES

Each person, firm, or corporation conducting or operating a boarding or rooming house within the City shall pay for the privilege for facilities available to more than four persons an annual license tax of \$10.00, plus \$2.00 for each sleeping or eating facility available in excess of four.

For the purpose of this section a boarding house shall be construed to mean any home or establishment, not including hotels, motels, restaurants, tourist homes, or the like which serves meals for compensation for not more than nine persons. For the purpose of this section a rooming house shall be construed to mean any home or establishment, not including hotels, motels, tourist homes, or the like, which offers sleeping facilities for regular occupancy by not more than nine persons for compensation.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
