

Ordinance No. 850

AN ORDINANCE to vacate and abandon two portions of an unnamed street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, more particularly described below.

WHEREAS, said vacation and abandonment have been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings, and

WHEREAS, a notice of application for appointment of viewers was posted at the Courthouse of the Corporation of Alexandria, Virginia, and at two other public places in the City in the manner required by law, and

WHEREAS, said viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria and have made their report, and

WHEREAS, on consideration of the report of said viewers and of other evidence relative to the proposed vacation and abandonment of the portions of the unnamed public street as aforesaid, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the portions of the street above mentioned and hereinafter described are not needed and that it is in the public interest to vacate the same.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described portions of an unnamed public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby are vacated and abandoned:

West Side of Taylor Run Parkway West (formerly Burgess Drive)
Beginning at a point at the northeast corner of lot 16, West End Subdiv.; thence running N 81° 15' 39" W 116.88' to a point at the northwest corner of lot 16, West End, thence running N 7° 59' 52" E 50.00' to a point, thence S 81° 15' 39" E 116.88' to a point, thence S 7° 59' 52" W. 50.00' to the point of beginning.

East Side of Taylor Run Parkway West (formerly Burgess Drive)
Beginning at a point at the northwest corner of lot 17 of the subdiv. of West End, thence running N 7° 59' 52" E 50.00' to a point, thence running S 81° 15' 39" E 190.00' more or less, to a point, thence S 0° 18' 58" E 50.42' more or less, to a point, thence N 81° 15' 39" W 201.00' more or less, to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
