

Ordinance No. 857

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 28-2 and Section 28-3, Article I, Chapter 28 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which said Section 28-2 relates to CONSTRUCTION OF CURB AND GUTTER UPON PETITION OF PROPERTY OWNER, which said Section 28-3 relates to CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS UPON PETITION OF PROPERTY OWNER, which said Article I relates to Streets and Sidewalks in General, and which said Chapter 28 relates to STREETS AND SIDEWALKS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 28-2, Article I, Chapter 28 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 28-2 CONSTRUCTION OF CURB AND GUTTER UPON PETITION OF PROPERTY OWNER

Upon petition by any property owner, the city shall, upon the approval of the City Manager, construct curbs and gutters at the proper lines and at grades to be determined by the Director of Public Works, in the street in front of the property of the petitioner; provided, that before such construction is commenced, the property owner shall pay to the city the actual cost of such construction as computed by the Director of Public Works at the time of said petition.

Section 2. That Section 28-3, Article I, Chapter 28 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 28-3 CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS UPON PETITION OF PROPERTY OWNER

Upon petition by any property owner, the city shall, upon approval by the City Manager, construct four foot concrete sidewalks at proper grades to be determined by the Director of Public Works in the street in front of the property of the petitioner; provided, that before such construction is commenced, the property owner shall pay to the city the actual cost of such construction as computed by the Director of Public Works at the time of said petition

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 1955.
