

Ordinance No. 875

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 17-49, Article II, of Chapter 17 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which said Section 17-49 relates to COIN-OPERATED DEVICES—COIN-OPERATED RADIOS IN HOTEL ROOMS, ETC., which said Article II relates to REGULATORY LICENSES, and which said Chapter 17 relates to LICENSES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 17-49, Article II, Chapter 17 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 17-49. COIN-OPERATED DEVICES—COIN-OPERATED RADIOS AND TELEVISION SETS IN HOTEL ROOMS, ETC.

On every coin-operated radio or television set installed in a hotel room, hospital room or other place, or in booths or on tables or counters in eating places, there is hereby levied an annual license tax of \$3.00 on each such radio or television set. If the radio or television set installation is so arranged that more than one radio or television mechanism is assembled in one cabinet, each such mechanism shall be construed a separate taxable unit under this section.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
