

Ordinance No. 879

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 35-3, Article II, Chapter 35, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended; which said Sec. 35-3 relates to ZONE BOUNDARIES and ADOPTION OF ZONING MAPS, which said Article II relates to ZONES AND GENERAL PROVISIONS, and which said Chapter 35 relates to ZONING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a daily paper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and by mailing, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the "FOURTH REVISED ZONING MAP" described and referred to in Sec. 35-3, Article II, Chapter 35, of The Code of The City of Alexandria, Virginia 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended in the particulars following so that the pieces of property hereinafter listed are changed to the zone specified:

- A. All of Lots 2, 3 and 4, Block 6, Assessment Map 131, being further described as all of the west side of the 300 block of North Washington Street, being between Queen and Princess Streets. FROM R-C residential to C-3 commercial.
- B. All of Lots 30 through 37 inclusive, Block 3, Assessment Map 118, being the northeast corner of Henry and Wolfe Streets, as follows: "Start at southeast corner, Block 3, (northeast corner South Henry and Wolfe Streets) run N 246.9 feet to alley between Lots 37 and 1 C, thence E. 100 feet to Court, thence South along said Court to Wolfe Street, thence West to beginning." FROM I-1 light industrial to I-2 heavy industrial.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
