

Ordinance No. 886

AN ORDINANCE to amend Article III, Chapter 28 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, by adding thereto a new section numbered 28-40.1, which Chapter 28 relates to STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, which Article III relates to STREET NAMES, and which new section numbered 28-40.1 relates to CHANGING THE NAME OF OLD SEMINARY ROAD TO RADFORD STREET.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Article III, Chapter 28 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section thereto numbered 28-40.1 to read as follows:

SEC. 28-40.1. CHANGE AS OF JANUARY 1, 1956

That effective January 1, 1956, the unnamed City street sometimes called Old Seminary Road, running from King Street extended north to Quaker Lane, be and hereby is named and designated Radford Street and shall be delineated on the official street naming map, City of Alexandria, Virginia, referred to in Section 28-41 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
