

## Ordinance No. 888

**AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Subsection 7, Section 9 of Ordinance No. 290, known as the Building Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, adopted May 23, 1939, and made effective July 21, 1939, as amended by Ordinnace No. 855, adopted and made effective May 24, 1955, which Subsection 7 relates to FEES AND PERMITS FOR INSPECTION OF MACHINERY INSTALLED, which Section 9 relates to FEES AND PERMITS GENERALLY, which Ordinance No. 290 is THE BUILDING CODE OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, and which Ordinance No. 855 relates to FEES AND PERMITS FOR INSPECTION OF MACHINERY INSTALLED.**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Subsection 7, Section 9 of Ordinance No. 290, adopted May 23, 1939 and made effective July 21, 1939, as amended by Ordinance No. 855, adopted and made effective May 24, 1955, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

7. The fees to be charged for inspection of and permits for any machinery, appliance or equipment pursuant to Chapter XIII A of this Code shall be seven tenths of one percent (.7%) of the cost of such machinery, appliance or equipment and the installation thereof.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
