

# Ordinance No. 894

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of South Gordon Street, a public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, said portion being located along the west line of said street, south of the intersection of South Gordon Street and Duke Street, in said City, and hereinafter described in detail.**

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings, and

WHEREAS, a notice of application for appointment of viewers was posted at the Courthouse of the Corporation Court of Alexandria, Virginia, and at two other public places in the City in the manner required by law, and

WHEREAS, said viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, and have made their report, and

WHEREAS, on consideration of the report of said viewers recommending said vacation, and of other evidence relative thereto, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the portion of the public street abovementioned and hereinafter described is not needed for public use and that it is in the public interest to vacate the same.

## THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described portion of South Gordon Street, a public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned:

Beginning at a point on the easterly boundary of land owned by W. M. Rose et ux, which point is S 44° 30' W 57.14 ft. from the present northeasterly corner of said land; thence following the easterly boundary of said land S 44° 30' W 50.51 ft. to an angle point; thence following the easterly boundary of said land S 17° 56' W 59.60 ft. to a point on a curve; thence reversing direction and following the arc of a curve to the left, whose radius is 423.70 ft.; whose delta is 13° 04' 48"; whose chord is 96.52 ft., whose chord bearing is N 30° 45' 24" E, a distance of 96.73 ft. to a tangent point; thence running N 24° 13' E 10.73 ft. to point of beginning and containing 910 sq. ft.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
