

Ordinance No. 905

AN ORDINANCE allotting the proceeds of the sale of \$2,300,000.00 City of Alexandria, Virginia Public Improvement Bonds to various capital accounts and appropriating from those accounts funds to be used for acquiring and improving lands for public parks, including playgrounds as a part thereof and constructing and equipping buildings and park improvements thereon; constructing and equipping a municipal traffic control building; completing an incinerator now under construction; remodeling and enlarging the existing City Jail and acquiring necessary land and equipment; acquiring and improving land for use as a City Yard and constructing and equipping a City Shop thereon; remodeling and equipping the building now owned by the City and known as Ramsay House for municipal purposes, including City offices; constructing and equipping fire house, additions to existing fire houses, installing a fire alarm system, and acquiring necessary land and equipment; constructing storm water sewers; constructing sanitary sewers; and constructing, paving, widening and otherwise improving streets, including bridges, viaducts and under-passes, and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the sum of \$2,300,000.00 be and the same hereby is allotted to and appropriated from the following bond accounts of the City of Alexandria, Virginia in the amounts listed and for the purposes stated:

- (1) The Public Parks Bonds Account to be used for acquiring and improving lands for public parks, including playgrounds as a part thereof and constructing and equipping buildings and park improvements thereon - \$110,000.00
- (2) The Traffic Control Building Bond Account to be used for constructing and equipping a municipal traffic control building ----- 56,000.00
- (3) The Incinerator Bond Account to be used for completing an incinerator now under construction ----- 32,000.00
- (4) The City Jail Bond account to be used for remodeling and enlarging the existing City Jail and acquiring necessary land and equipment ----- 400,000.00
- (5) The City Yard and Shop Bond Account to be used for acquiring and improving land for use as a City Yard and constructing and equipping a City Shop thereon -- 150,000.00
- (6) The Ramsay House Bond Account to be used for remodeling and equipping the building now owned by

the City and known as Ramsay House for municipal purposes, including City offices -----	24,000.00
(7) Fire House, Alarm System and Equipment Bond Account to be used for constructing and equipping fire houses, additions to existing fire houses, installing a fire alarm system and acquiring necessary land and equipment -----	210,000.00
(8) Storm Water Sewers Bond Accounts to be used for constructing storm water sewers -----	617,000.00
(9) Sanitary Sewers Bond Account to be used for constructing sanitary sewers -----	165,000.00
(10) Street Bond Account to be used for constructing, paving, widening and otherwise improving streets, including bridges, viaducts and under-passes, and acquisition of necessary land and rights of way -----	536,000.00

Section 2. That before any project, calling for the expenditure of the funds allotted and appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance, be started, such project must be approved by a majority vote of the Council members present at any lawful meeting of the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 3. That before any funds, allotted and appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance are expended, such expenditure must be approved by a majority vote of the Council members present at any lawful meeting of the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
