

# Ordinance No. 906

**AN ORDINANCE to amend Division 1, Article III, Chapter 19 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, by adding a new section thereto designated Section 19-57.1, which said Section 19-57.1 relates to DRIVING WITHOUT LICENSE PROHIBITED, which said Division 1 relates to OPERATION OF VEHICLES IN GENERAL, which said Article III relates to OPERATION OF VEHICLES, and which said Chapter 19 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC.**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Division 1, Article III, of Chapter 19 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section thereto designated Section 19-57.1, to read as follows:

Sec. 19-57.1 DRIVING WITHOUT LICENSE PROHIBITED.

No person, except those expressly exempted by Article II, Chapter 5, of the Code of Virginia, (1950) as amended, shall drive any motor vehicle upon any street or highway in the City of Alexandria until such person shall have made application for an operator's or chauffeur's license as provided by Article IV, Chapter 5, Title 46 of Virginia, (1950) as amended, and satisfactorily passed the examination required by Section 46-365 of the Code of Virginia, (1950) as amended, and obtained either an operator's or chauffeur's license, unless such person shall have been issued an operator's or chauffeur's license prior to June 19, 1946, that is renewable in the discretion of the Division of Motor Vehicles of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
