

Ordinance No. 909

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of North Chambliss Street, one of the public streets of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has reconsidered the vacation of the hereinafter described portion of North Chambliss Street and,

WHEREAS, the viewers appointed by the City Council have recommended the vacation of the hereinafter described portion of North Chambliss Street and,

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law for such vacations have been followed and,

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that the hereinafter described portion of North Chambliss Street is no longer required for public use and it is in the best interest to abandon it.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. That the portion of North Chambliss Street, one of the public streets of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, running from the North boundary of lot numbered 143, section two Lincoln Hills subdivision in a northerly direction to the land of M. T. Broyhill which abuts said subdivision on the north, be abandoned and vacated as a public street.

2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
