

Ordinance No. 914

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sections 1-15, 1-16, 1-20 (g), 1-20 (h), Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Section 1-15 relates to the BOUNDARY OF THE SEVENTH WARD, which Section 1-16 relates to the BOUNDARY OF THE EIGHTH WARD, which Section 1-20 (g) relates to SEVENTH WARD ELECTION DISTRICT AND VOTING PLACE, which Section 1-20 (h) relates to EIGHTH WARD ELECTION DISTRICT AND VOTING PLACE, and which Chapter 1 relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 1-15, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 1-15 BOUNDARY OF THE SEVENTH WARD

The boundary of the Seventh Ward shall be as follows: Beginning at the intersection of S. Quaker Lane (formerly Seminary Lane) with the centerline at Cameron Run on the south corporate limits, as established in 1951, and running thence with said south and west corporate limits in a generally westerly direction to the intersection of said limits with the centerline of Shirley Highway; thence running northerly along the centerline of said Shirley Highway to a point where the west boundary line of the Francis Hammond High School property intersects said centerline; thence leaving said centerline and following the west boundary of the Francis Hammond High School extended, and the southwest boundary of said High School property to its intersection with the centerline of Pegram Street; thence following the centerline of Pegram Street in a generally northeasterly direction approximately 1,400 feet to its intersection with the centerline of Pickett Street; thence following the centerline of Pickett Street in a northerly direction to its intersection with the centerline of Seminary Road; thence westerly along the centerline of Seminary Road to its intersection with the centerline of the aforementioned Shirley Highway; thence northerly along the centerline of Shirley Highway to its intersection with the Arlington County line, lying just north of the centerline of King Street (Leesburg Turnpike); thence easterly along the Arlington County line to its intersection with the centerline of N. Quaker Lane; thence southerly along the centerline of said Quaker Lane to its intersection with the centerline of Duke Street; thence easterly along said centerline of Duke Street to its intersection with the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence southerly along the intersection of said South Quaker Lane to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That Section 1-16, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 1-16 BOUNDARY OF THE EIGHTH WARD

The boundary of the Eighth Ward shall be as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway on the southwesterly corporate limits, as established in 1951, running thence westerly and northerly on the southwesterly and westerly corporate limits of 1951, to the Arlington

County line; thence easterly along the Arlington County line to its intersection with the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence southerly with the centerline of the Shirley Memorial Highway to its intersection with the centerline of Seminary Road (Route 615); thence easterly along the centerline of Seminary Road at its intersection with the centerline of Pickett Street (formerly Valley Lane); thence following the centerline of Pickett Street to its intersection with the centerline of Pegram Street; thence following the centerline of Pegram Street in a generally southwesterly direction, approximately 1,400 feet to its intersection with the southwesterly boundary of the property of the Francis Hammond High School property extended; thence following the southwest boundary of the Francis Hammond High School and the west boundary of the said school extended, to its intersection with the centerline of the aforementioned Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence following the centerline of the said Shirley Memorial Highway southerly to the point of beginning.

Section 3. That Section 1-20 (g), Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

**Sec. 1-20 (g) SEVENTH WARD. Lee-Jackson School
Election District and Voting Place**

The Lee-Jackson School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of S. Quaker Lane (formerly Seminary Lane) with the centerline at Cameron Run on the south corporate limits, as established in 1951, and running thence with said south and west corporate limits in a generally westerly direction to the intersection of said limits with the centerline of Shirley Highway; thence running northerly along the centerline of said Shirley Highway to a point where the west boundary line of the Francis Hammond High School property intersects said centerline; thence leaving said centerline and following the west boundary of the Francis Hammond High School extended, and the southwest boundary of said High School property to its intersection with the centerline of Pegram Street; thence following the centerline of Pegram Street in a generally northeasterly direction approximately 1,400 feet to its intersection with the centerline of Pickett Street; thence following the centerline of Pickett Street in a northerly direction to its intersection with the centerline of Seminary Road; thence westerly along the centerline of Seminary Road to its intersection with the centerline of the aforementioned Shirley Highway; thence northerly along the centerline of Shirley Highway to its intersection with the Arlington County line, lying just north of the centerline of King Street (Leesburg Turnpike); thence easterly along the Arlington County line to its intersection with the centerline of N. Quaker Lane; thence southerly along the centerline of said Quaker Lane to its intersection with the centerline of Duke Street; thence easterly along said centerline of Duke Street to its intersection with the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence southerly along the intersection of said South Quaker Lane to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Lee-Jackson School Election District shall be at the Lee-Jackson School located at the southwest corner of the intersection of South Quaker Lane and Duke Street.

Section 4. That Section 1-20 (h), Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 1-20 (h) EIGHTH WARD. The Francis Hammond School Election District and Voting Place

The Francis Hammond School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway on the southwesterly corporate limits, as established in 1951, running thence westerly and northerly on the southwesterly and westerly corporate limits of 1951, to the Arlington County line; thence easterly along the Arlington County line to its intersection with the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence southerly with the centerline of the Shirley Memorial Highway to its intersection with the centerline of Seminary Road (Route 615); thence easterly along the centerline of Seminary Road at its intersection with the centerline of Pickett Street (formerly Valley Lane); thence following the centerline of Pickett Street to its intersection with the centerline of Pegram Street; thence following the centerline of Pegram Street in a generally southwesterly direction, approximately 1,400 feet to its intersection with the southwesterly boundary of the property of the Francis Hammond High School property extended; thence following the southwest boundary of the Francis Hammond High School and the west boundary of the said school extended, to its intersection with the centerline of the aforementioned Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence following the centerline of the said Shirley Memorial Highway southerly to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Francis Hammond School Election District shall be at the Francis Hammond School located at the corner of Pickett Street and Seminary Road.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
