

# Ordinance No. 917

**AN ORDINANCE to amend Article VI, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, by adding new sections thereto numbered Sections 2-107, 2-108, 2-109, 2-110, 2-111, and 2-112, which Section 2-107 relates to RETIREMENT PLAN FOR POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL, which Section 2-108 relates to RETIREMENT PLAN FOR OTHER CITY EMPLOYEES, which Section 2-109 relates to PARTICIPATION IN RETIREMENT PLANS, WHEN MANDATORY, which Section 2-110 relates to GROUP LIFE INSURANCE PLAN, which Section 2-111 relates to PARTICIPATION IN LIFE INSURANCE PLAN, which Section 2-112 relates to WITHHOLDING AND PAYMENT OF CITY SHARE, which Article VI relates to PERSONNEL, and which Chapter 2 relates to ADMINISTRATION.**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Article VI, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding new sections thereto numbered 2-107, 2-108, 2-109, 2-110, 2-111, and 2-112 to read as follows:

**Sec. 2-107 RETIREMENT PLAN FOR POLICE AND  
FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL**

The pension and disability plan of the Connecticut General Life Insurance Company submitted January 4, 1956, is hereby adopted for the personnel of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, to become effective on and after July 1, 1956, and the City Manager is authorized to sign all contracts and papers for and on behalf of the City in connection with said plan.

**Sec. 2-108 RETIREMENT PLAN FOR OTHER CITY EMPLOYEES**

The Virginia Retirement Plan of the Commonwealth of Virginia, as provided by the General Laws of the Commonwealth, is hereby adopted for the eligible employees of the City other than police and firemen, to become effective on and after January 1, 1957.

**Sec. 2-109 PARTICIPATION IN RETIREMENT PLANS,  
WHEN MANDATORY**

All employees on the payroll of the City on July 1, 1956, and January 1, 1957, shall have their choice as to whether or not they wish to participate in the plans adopted above. All persons employed in the Police and Fire Departments after July 1, 1956 and all persons employed by other City departments after January 1, 1957 shall be required to join and participate in their respective plans.

**Sec. 2-110 GROUP LIFE INSURANCE PLAN**

The Group Life Insurance Plan of the Lincoln National Life Insurance Company of Indiana, submitted by Charles F. Leef Febru-

ary 24, 1956, is hereby adopted as the life insurance plan for all employees of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, to become effective at the earliest practicable date, and the City Manager is authorized to sign all contracts and papers for and on behalf of the City in connection with said plan.

**Sec. 2-111 PARTICIPATION IN LIFE INSURANCE PLAN**

Employees are not required to participate in the life insurance plan and participation shall be entirely voluntary.

**Sec. 2-112 WITHHOLDING AND PAYMENT OF CITY SHARE**

The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to deduct and withhold employees' contributions, either voluntary or mandatory, for the plans adopted above.

The Director of Finance is further authorized to expend the share of the City of Alexandria toward maintaining these plans.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
