

Ordinance No. 920

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain a portion of Section 35-86, Article XV, Chapter 35, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Section 35-86 relates to APPLICATIONS FOR AMENDMENTS TO ZONING LAWS, GENERALLY, which Article XV relates to AMENDMENTS, ETC., and which Chapter 35 relates to ZONING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a daily paper of general circulation in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the first paragraph of Section 35-86, Article XV, Chapter 35, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Applications for amendment, supplement or change in this chapter made by the owner of property or parties in interest shall be addressed to the Council and shall be filed with the Director of Planning. Each such application for change in zoning classification of property shall correctly list the names and addresses of all abutting property owners, and when the property borders on a street, public way or public service company right of way, the names and addresses of the property owners directly opposite the property across such street, public way or public service company right of way. Each such application shall be accompanied by a check or money order in at least the sum of fifty dollars to cover costs in connection with the application and it shall be the duty of the City Manager to ascertain in any case whether or not such sum will cover the costs in connection therewith, and if not, he shall require such additional sum as will actually cover such costs.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
