

## Ordinance No. 927

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate that portion of Wythe Street lying west of West Street and east of Braddock Road, said Wythe Street being a public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.**

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission, and

WHEREAS, a notice of application for appointment of viewers was posted at the Courthouse of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and at two other public places in the city in the manner required by law, and

WHEREAS, said viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by said viewers, and

WHEREAS, acting pursuant to the laws provided for in such cases, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia that the portion of the public street above mentioned and designated for vacation, is not needed for public use and it is in the public interest to vacate the same.

### THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That all of that portion of Wythe Street, a public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, lying west of West Street and east of Braddock Road, and more particularly described below, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned.

Beginning at a point on the westerly side of West Street, said point being the northeast corner of Lot 500 as shown on a plat of the division of the property of Cassius Carter, Jr., recorded among the land records of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, in Deed Book 252 at page 8; thence departing from West Street and running along the southerly line of Wythe Street, as presently located, and with the line of lot 500 and continuing with a portion of the line of lot 501 of said division N 74° 47' W 123.42 feet to a point; thence running with another line of lot 501 and the westerly line of Wythe Street N 15° 13' E 66 feet to a point in the northerly line of Wythe Street as presently located; thence with the northerly line of Wythe Street S 74° 47' E 123.42 feet to a point in the westerly line of West Street; thence with the westerly line of West Street S 15° 13' W 66 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
