

Ordinance No. 931

AN ORDINANCE appropriating and allotting a sum of money to purchase a parcel of land in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, for use as a public school site.

WHEREAS, an elementary school is badly needed in the western portion of the City, and

WHEREAS, there is available in the general fund of the City a sum unencumbered and unappropriated sufficient to defray the purchase price of a site for such a school.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the sum of Forty Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$40,300.00) be and hereby is appropriated from the general fund and allocated to the general fund school site account, to be used for the purchase of an elementary school site in that portion of the City west of the Shirley Highway.

Section 2. That the City Manager be and hereby is authorized to negotiate for such purchase and do all things necessary to consummate the purchase.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
