

Ordinance No. 935

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Subparagraph (c) and Subparagraph (g), Section 1-20, Chapter 1, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Subparagraph (c) relates to THIRD WARD. JEFFERSON SCHOOL ELECTION DISTRICT AND VOTING PLACE; POWHATAN ELECTION DISTRICT AND VOTING PLACE, which Subparagraph (g) relates to SEVENTH WARD. LEE-JACKSON SCHOOL ELECTION DISTRICT AND VOTING PLACE, which Section 1-20 relates to ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES, and which Chapter 1 relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS OF THE CITY CODE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Subparagraph (c), Section 1-20, Chapter 1, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 1-20 (c) THIRD WARD. CAMERON STREET RECREATION CENTER ELECTION DISTRICT AND VOTING PLACE; POWHATAN ELECTION DISTRICT AND VOTING PLACE

The third ward shall be divided into Cameron Street Recreation Center Election District and Powhatan Election District.

The Cameron Street Recreation Center Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of King Street and the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence north along this right-of-way line to Oronoco Street; thence east along Oronoco Street to Washington Street; thence south on Washington Street to King Street; thence west on King Street to the place of beginning.

The Powhatan Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Oronoco Street and Washington Street; thence north along Washington Street to the northern city boundary; thence westward on said boundary to Jefferson Davis Highway; thence south on Jefferson Davis Highway to Monroe Avenue; thence along the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad to Oronoco Street; thence east on Oronoco Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Cameron Street Recreation Center Election District shall be at the Cameron Street Recreation Center located on the north side of Cameron Street at Cameron and Harvard Streets.

The voting place within the Powhatan Election District shall be

at the Traffic Control Building located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Powhatan and Bernard Streets.

Section 2. That Subparagraph (g), Section 1-20, Chapter 1, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 1-20 (g) SEVENTH WARD. PATRICK HENRY SCHOOL ELECTION DISTRICT AND VOTING PLACE

The Patrick Henry School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of South Quaker Lane (formerly Seminary Lane) with the centerline at Cameron Run on the south corporate limits, as established in 1951, and running thence with said south and west corporate limits in a generally westerly direction to the intersection of said limits with the centerline of Shirley Highway; thence running northerly along the centerline of said Shirley Highway to a point where the west boundary line of the Francis Hammond High School property intersects said centerline; thence leaving said centerline and following the west boundary of the Francis Hammond High School extended, and the southwest boundary of said High School property to its intersection with the centerline of Pegram Street; thence following the centerline of Pegram Street in a generally northeasterly direction approximately 1,400 feet to its intersection with the centerline of Pickett Street; thence following the centerline of Pickett Street in a northerly direction to its intersection with the centerline of Seminary Road; thence westerly along the centerline of Seminary Road to its intersection with the centerline of the aforementioned Shirley Highway; thence northerly along the centerline of Shirley Highway to its intersection with the Arlington County line, lying just north of the centerline of King Street (Leesburg Turnpike); thence easterly along the Arlington County line to its intersection with the centerline of North Quaker Lane; thence southerly along the centerline of said Quaker Lane to its intersection with the centerline of Duke Street; thence easterly along said centerline of Duke Street to its intersection with the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence southerly along the intersection of said South Quaker Lane to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Patrick-Henry School Election District shall be at the Patrick Henry School located on the north side of Taney Avenue between Latham and Howard Streets.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
